

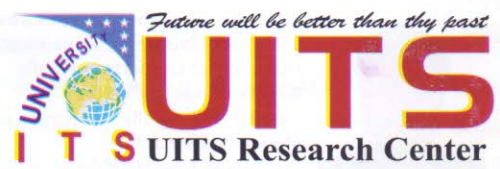

Introduction

The guiding spirit behind the endeavor is, "divine blessings, mixed with hard work, and backed by good intentions, make miracles". The university has already started spreading its reputation at home and abroad. Established in 2003 by the PHP Family, a leading group of industries in Bangladesh, the university has been providing quality education at an affordable cost. As a result the university attracts a good number of foreign students in every semester. Most of the faculty members are highly qualified from Dhaka University, Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET), and renowned foreign universities i.e. USA, EU, Australia, Japan, India, China, and Korea. 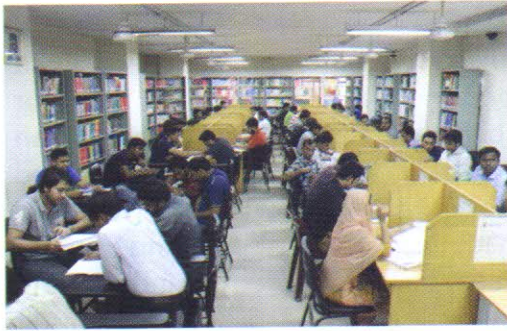

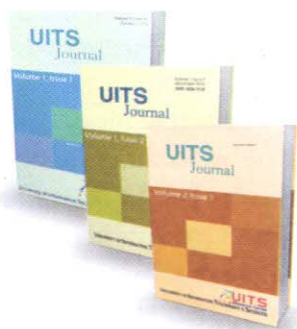

Website Launching Ceremony



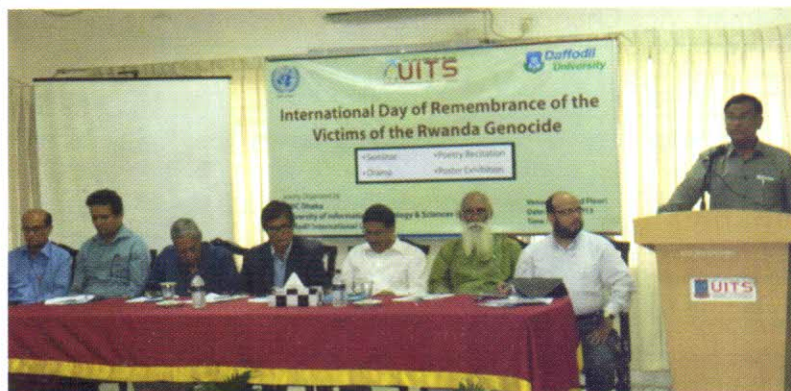

MoU between UIITS & WAB

The UIITS has signed an agreement of partnership with Water Aid. This strategic partnership will remain valid for maximum 4 years commencing from January 1st 2013 to December 31, 2016. Water Aid will provide inputs for UIITS with technical assistance from CSE. The University will allocate a designated space for establishing a Rain Center and provide necessary support for promoting rainwater harvesting among students and teachers. The university will participate in different relevant initiatives taken by Water Aid and extend technical support to them, if needed.

UIITS and WAB will ensure the successful expedition of this partnership.

MoA with Texas A & M University

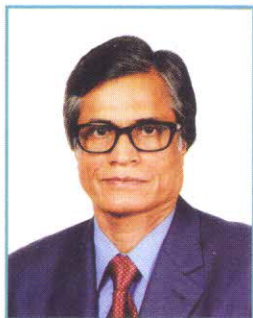
have signed the agreement respectively on behalf of their institutions. UITS students can have the

Dr. Muhammad Samad elected APASWE Board Member



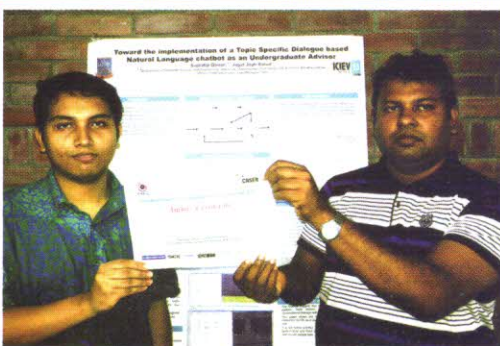
